New students to Gavilan College may obtain an exemption to the assessment, orientation and counseling/education plan/core requirements if they fit one or more of the criteria listed below. If you would like to be exempt from these services, **circle the number(s) below** that apply to your situation.  
**Please note: priority registration is not available to students who exempt out of the core requirements.**

<b>1.</b>	Have completed an associate degree or higher.
<b>2.</b>	Are planning to enroll in courses at Gavilan College solely to maintain industry or licensure requirements.
<b>3.</b>	Are planning to enroll in classes for a reason other than career development or advancement, transfer, attainment of a degree or certificate of achievement, or completion of a basic skills course sequence.
<b>4.</b>	Special admit (concurrently enrolled high school student)
