COURSE DESCRIPTION:

General work experience is for students who have a job unrelated to their major. General work experience is supervised employment which is intended to assist students in acquiring desirable work habits, attitudes and career awareness. A training plan is developed cooperatively between the employer, college and student. CWE 192B is designed specifically for students who have been employed for more than 9 months with an emphasis on enhancing leadership, communication, advancement, research and planning skills. (Pass/no pass grading) 75 hours per semester of paid work = 1 unit. 60 hours of non-paid (volunteer) work per semester = 1 unit. May be taken for a maximum of 16 units. Minimum 2.0 GPA.
