●**Patrick Yuh** is a professor of Biology at Gavilan College. He holds dual Master's degrees in molecular biology and education. His graduate research focused on the spliceosome, a cellular machine that ensures our genes are properly expressed. As a member of the LGBTQ community, he is interested in the intersection of gender/sexuality and biology.

●**Dr. Nicholas Park** is a professor of Sociology at Gavilan College. His professional research interests focus on the sociology of families, with particular attention on adoption, infertility, motherhood and fatherhood, and same-sex parenting. He studies how gender systems shape our lives; he is also interested in media, and the environment.

●**Adrienne Keel** graduated with her BA in psychology from San Jose State University in 2010. She started her career working with LGBTQ Youth in Santa Clara County in 2009 as a facilitator of an LGBTQ youth support group at Andrew Hill High School in San Jose.
