Late	January 26 – February 6	Students who have obtained add codes from instructors

- Priority 1, Priority 2 and Continuing student priority eligibility criteria includes good academic standing e.g. not on probation for 2 consecutive semesters or dismissal; less than 100 units total excluding 30 units basic skills or ESL classes.
- New student priority eligibility includes successful completion of assessment, education plan and orientation.
