Requirements for Theory Instructor: Master's in nursing **OR** bachelor's in nursing **AND** master's in health education or health science **OR** the equivalent **OR** the minimum qualifications as set by the Board of Registered Nursing and Board of Vocational Nursing, whichever is higher. Hold a current California active license as a Registered Nurse. **Course in teaching.**

Requirements for Clinical Instructor: Bachelor's in Nursing from an accredited college which includes courses in nursing or in natural, behavioral or social sciences relevant to nursing practice. Two years direct patient care experience as a registered nurse in pediatric nursing. A course in teaching. Current Active RN license.

This position requires development and review of curriculum, as well as, assessment of student learning.
