



Spring 2005 Class Filling by Time of Day

This report only includes census type classes that are 3 units and above taught at the Gilroy site with set meeting times. By the end of late registration, no time of day has a majority of sections at capacity. Afternoon classes (those that start between 12 pm and 4 pm) appear to be intermediate between day and evening classes for reaching capacity. Evening classes are more likely fill to 25% to 74% of capacity.

About two-thirds of these sections exceed an enrollment level of 15 students therefore being less likely to be cancelled. Day sections are more likely to exceed this threshold compared to afternoon and evening sections.
