Dear Student.

Welcome to the Fall 2025 C.N.A. Program at Gavilan College. In order to participate in the clinical portion of the program, you must complete and submit all the following requirements by the first day of class: Tuesday, August 12, 2025.

Failure to meet these requirements will result in your ineligibility to attend clinical, which may prevent you from completing the program.

✓ Clinical Requirements Checklist

Please provide **official documentation** for each of the following: Must be completed through **CastleBranch** (We will not be collecting any official/personal documents)

- 1. TB QuantiFERON Gold Blood Test
 - Must be completed after May 28, 2025
 - Must show **Negative** results (lab report required)
 - o If Positive, submit a clear chest X-ray report or physician verification
- 2. **Rubella Titer** Positive result required
- 3. **Mumps Titer** Positive result required
- Measles Titer Positive result required
- 5. Varicella (Chickenpox) Titer Positive result required
- 6. **Hepatitis B Titer** Positive result required
- 7. Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis (Tdap)
 - Must be within the last 10 years
- 8. Flu Vaccination
 - For the current 2024–2025 flu season (August 2024–April 2025)
- 9. COVID-19 Vaccination + Booster
 - Submit proof of full vaccination and booster

10. Drug & Alcohol Screening

- Ten-panel + alcohol test

11. Live Scan Fingerprinting

- Submit proof of Live Scan receipt on August 12, 2025 (first day of class)
- Complete all 3 Live Scan forms included in your packet (bring 3 copies first day of class)
- Follow the sample form provided when filling out paperwork
- o **CDPH clearance** is required for state C.N.A. certification

▲ Important Reminders

- All requirements must be completed and submitted by Tuesday, August 12, 2025. Incomplete documentation will prevent you from attending clinical.
- Uniform & Textbooks:
 - Students are required to wear the **nursing uniform** during clinicals and skills lab days.
 - o Uniform information is available on the program website.
 - All required textbooks must be brought on the first day of class.
