Invitation to the **LVN program** is based on the multi-criteria distribution scores. The selection process is based on the multi criteria and lottery. Fifteen (15) applicants will be selected based on multi criteria points, remaining applicants will be placed in the lottery and 15 will be randomly selected. Ten (10) alternates will be selected. Applicants who are invited to the program must submit the "Intent to Enroll" within the stated deadline indicated on the Acceptance Letter. As slots become available alternates will be informed for availability. Wishing all applicants, a successful application experience.
