

Shushana Hakobyan is an accomplished Armenian pianist whose artistry and leadership have made a lasting impact on the international music scene. She holds a Master's degree in Piano Performance from the Komitas State Conservatory in Armenia and earned a Graduate Certificate in Keyboard Collaborative Arts from the University of Southern California, reflecting her dedication to both solo and collaborative performance at the highest level.

In collaboration with the renowned violinist and composer Ruben Aghiyan, she co-founded the *Unison Duet*. Together, they have led charitable initiatives in Armenia's border villages and recorded the album *Fantasy*, with all proceeds directed toward humanitarian causes.

Shushana was a leading soloist with the Armenian State Philharmonic and is a founding member of the SHELL Armenia State Philharmonic Trio. The trio toured extensively throughout Europe to critical acclaim and, following a long hiatus, has recently resumed touring across North America.

Shushana Hakobyan has performed at distinguished venues including the Interfaith Center at the Presidio and the Concert Society of Coraopolis. In October 2023, she presented a charitable concert in Toronto to raise funds for families affected by Azerbaijani aggression in Artsakh.

In 2024, she co-founded the international composition competition *Homecoming: Return To Artsakh* alongside prominent American composer Deon Nielsen Price, aiming to preserve and revitalize Artsakh's rich folk music traditions.

Beyond the stage, Shushana Hakobyan is the Founder and President of Music For Unity, an organization dedicated to fostering unity and positive social change through music. She is also the creator of the award-winning concert series *By the Piano with Shushana*, which continues to grow in recognition and reach.
