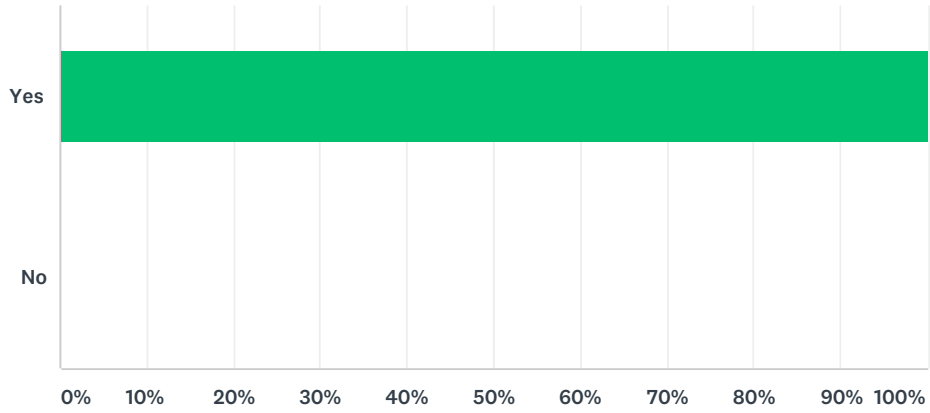


Q1 Are you ready to continue?

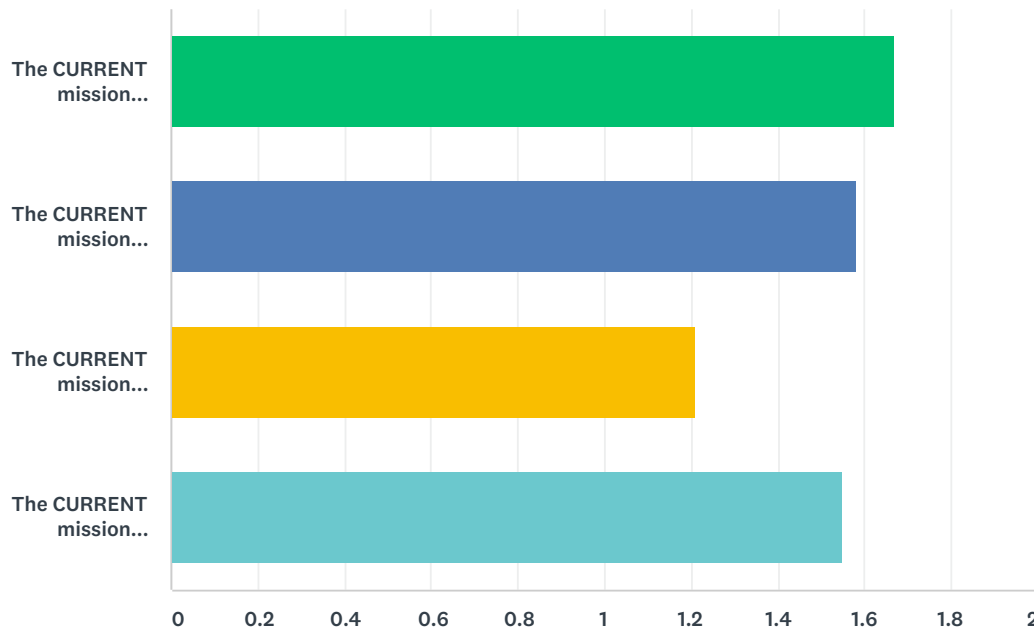

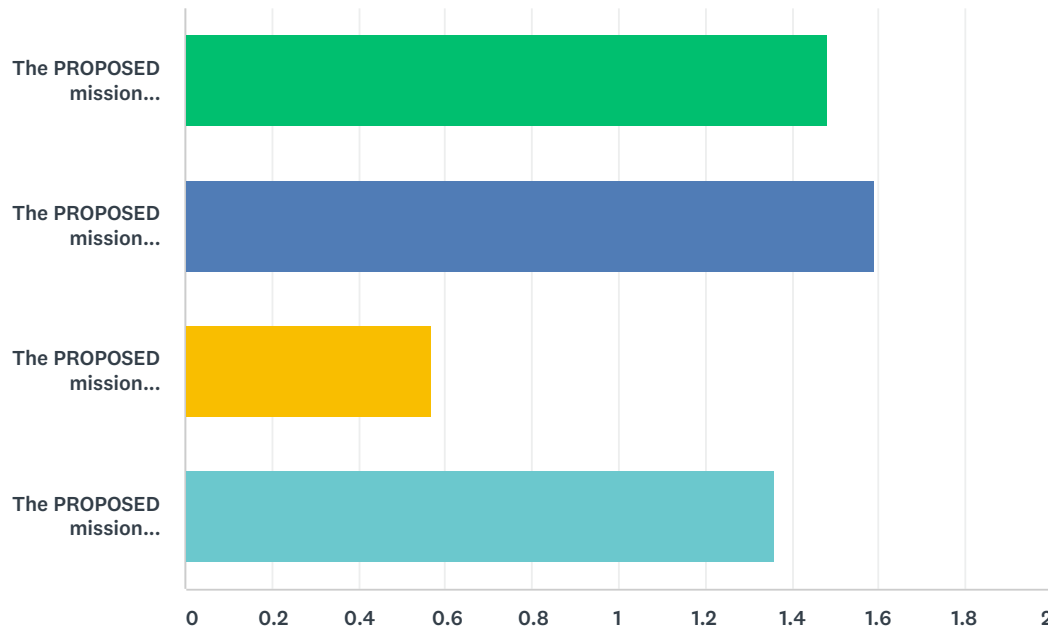

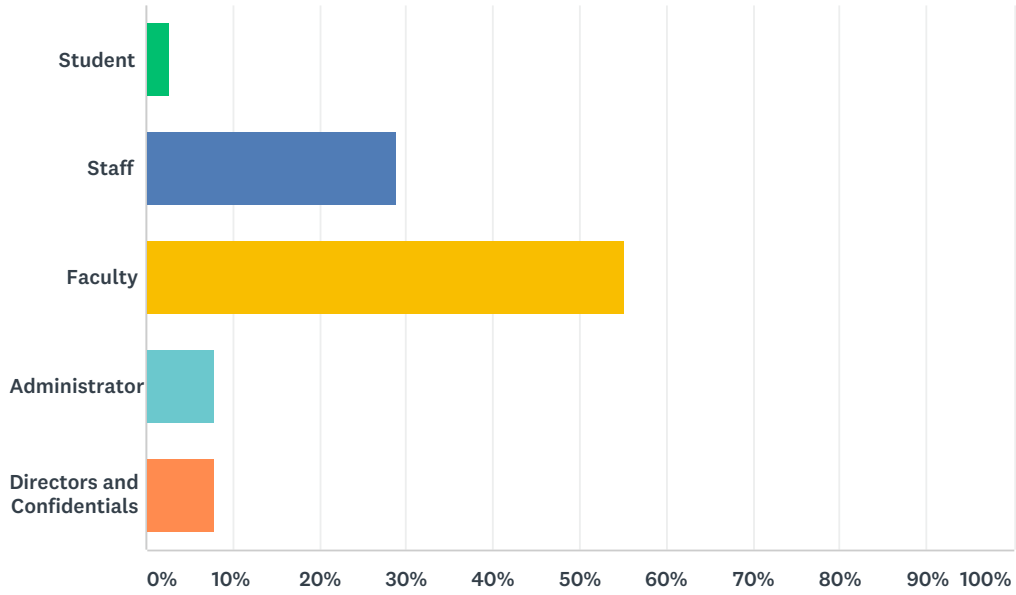

Q5 What is your role at Gavilan College?

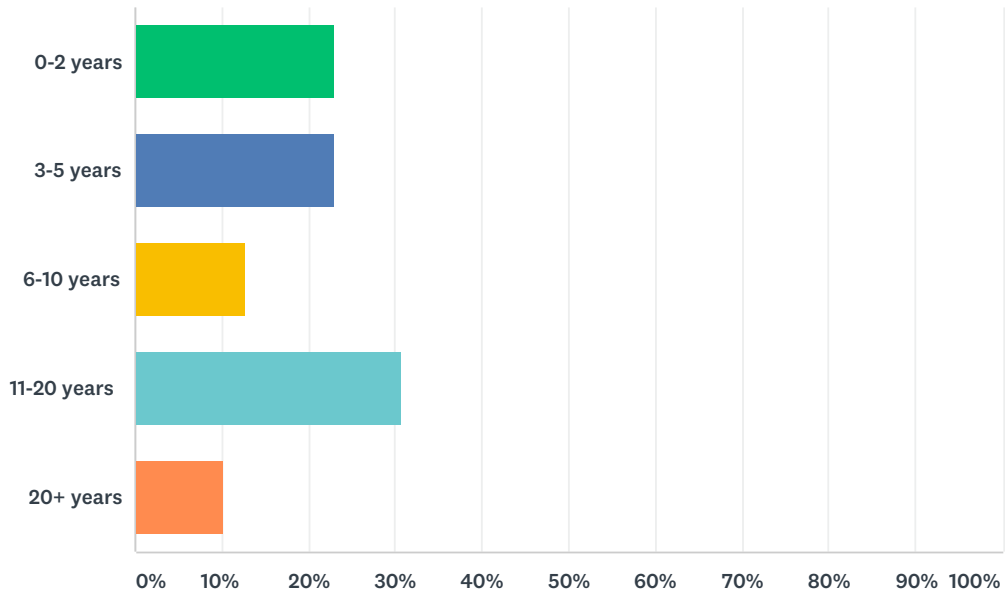

Q6 How long have you worked at Gavilan College

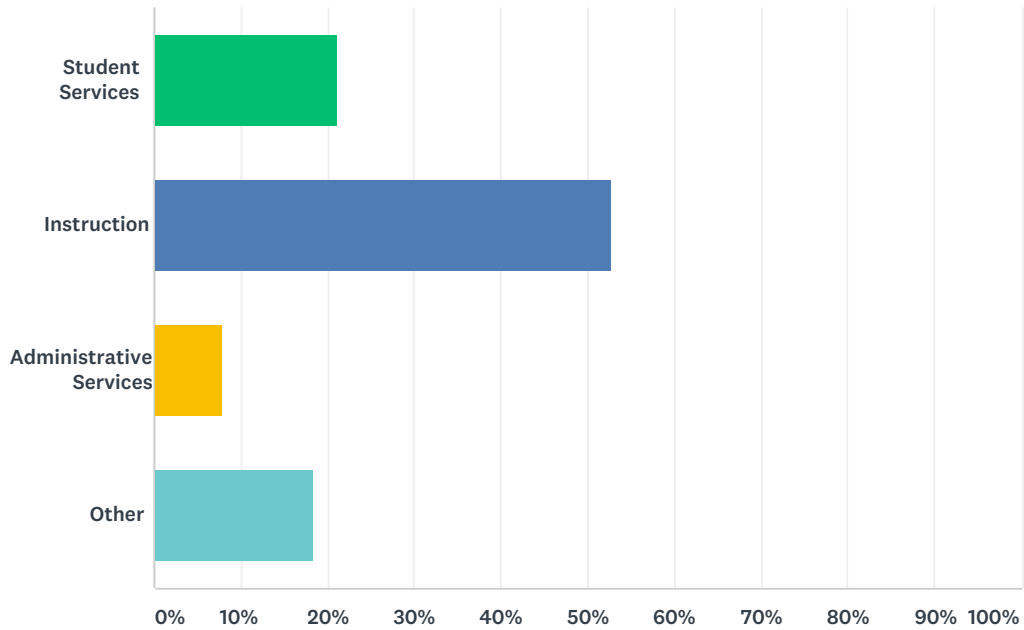
