Proposal:

2017-18 update regarding Gavilan College Fresh Success Program and Food Pantry.

Background:

Fresh Success is a program that launched in June of 2016. Fresh Success is a collaboration with the Foundation for California Community Colleges, the California Department of Social Services, the California Community College Chancellor's Office, the County of Santa Clara and San Benito, the California Employment Development Department and the US Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service. Fresh Success services students who are receiving or eligible to receive CalFresh benefits, living in Santa Clara or San Benito County, and are enrolled in permissible courses or have a declared CTE major. Some of the services include Ed-plan development, application assistance, textbook vouchers, transportation assistance, parking permits, rental, PG&E, and vehicle repair assistance.

The Food Pantry was established in May of 2016. The Food Pantry is a collaboration with Second Harvest Food Bank, St. Joseph's Family Center, ASGC, Equity, Gavilan College Fresh Success and CalWORKs programs. The Food Pantry is a free service available to the entire Gavilan College community.
