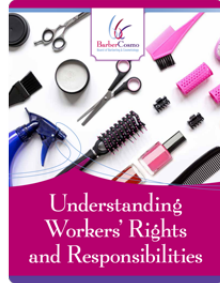

(California Business and Professions Code §§ 7314.3, 7337, & 7347). Pursuant to state law, every applicant for licensure or renewal will be required to include a signed acknowledgment on their respective applications that they understand the following informational material on basic labor laws.
