CSIS 575 is designed to provide instruction in effective use of assistive computer technology for reading and writing assistance. Students with disabilities will learn how to use text-to-speech and word prediction programs for improved reading, writing and study skills. Special emphasis will be placed on reading comprehension, vocabulary development, prewriting and editing for correct usage and research facilitation. After the training, you can use the software at home!
