Reference:

Education Code Section 79020; Title 5, Section 55700 et seq., Section 58142

One hundred seventy five (175) define an academic year (plus additional days per contract)

Five days are designated as flex

The academic calendar is determined through collective bargaining with the Gavilan College Faculty Association

Holidays, include:

- New Year's Day (January 1)
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
- Lincoln Day (February 12 or see Note below)
- Washington Day (Third Monday in February)
- Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
- Independence Day (July 4)
- Labor Day (First Monday in September)
- Veteran's Day (November 11 or see Note below)
- Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
- Christmas Day (December 25)

Other Holidays:

- New Year's Eve Day
- The day after Thanksgiving
- Christmas Eve Day

Note: Please refer to Education Code 79020 for laws regulating the scheduling of Lincoln Day, Veteran's Day, and holidays that fall on weekends.
