



RESIDENCY RECLASSIFICATION FORM

This form is to be completed by students requesting classification of their residence status for tuition purposes. Residency changes are not automatic. To be considered for California residency (*Title 5, 54020 and 54028*), you must:

- 1) Be physically present in California for at least one year and one day prior to the first day of the semester
- 2) Show documentation of intent to establish California residency dating at least one year and one day prior to the first day of the semester to be present
- 3) Not be precluded from establishing residency by provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act
 - The following visa status holders CANNOT establish residency:
B-1, B-2, C, D-1, D-2, F-1, F-2, H-2, H-3, J-1, J-2, M-1, M-2, O-2, P-1, P-2, P-3, P-4, Q and TN/TD.

Proof of residency must reflect:

- Student's name;
- Student's California address, documents indicating a post office box will not be accepted.
- Documents should be dated at least one year and one day prior to the beginning of the semester you plan to attend.
