CLEP credit **WILL NOT be used to certify the California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC)**. Some California State Universities will grant credit for certain areas, and some will not grant credit at all. Transfer students are advised to contact the university they will be attending for specific information regarding CLEP credit.
