

Registering for Classes at Gavilan College

Welcome to Gavilan College! To ensure you are ready to register for classes, please check that you have completed all <u>Steps for New Students</u> including the **Online Student Orientation** located on your MyGav Portal. For assistance with these steps connect with the <u>Welcome Center</u> or a <u>Gavilan College Counselor</u>.

How Do I Balance Work & School?

If you plan to work, please refer to the table below for the recommended work hours that correspond with the number of units you are taking. In general, one unit of credit equals one hour of lecture per week. A typical 4-unit course will require about 12 hours of work per week: 4 hours of class time and 8 hours of work outside of class. You should expect to spend **two hours studying for every unit**. *A full-time student is someone enrolled in 12+ units (4 or more classes).

Units Per Semester	Maximum Recommended Work Hours
12+ Units	10 - 20 hours per week
6-11 Units	20 - 29 hours per week
3-6 Units	30 - 40 hours per week

What Classes Should I Take My First Semester?



It is recommended that you take an English course, a math course, and two courses within your major your first semester. Please refer to your **MyDegreeWorks** page located in your MyGav portal for class options. You can also refer to the <u>Major</u>

<u>Course Options</u> document. If you are still Undecided on your major, we recommend that you enroll in General Education courses and Guidance 1 (Self-Assessment & Career Development). Please review the chart below:

How do I Choose My General Education (GE) Pattern?

There are two general education patterns that lead to an associate's degree.

GE Pattern	Who Should Select This Pattern?
Option A – CalGETC CalGETC + Major = Transfer and AA/AS	 Transfer-bound students who are planning to attend: University of California (UC) campus California State University (CSU) campus Considering private or out of state schools Undecided about transfer institution Students considering applying to both UC and CSU campuses
Option B – Gavilan GE Gav GE + Major Prep = AA/AS	Students who plan to receive an AA/AS only and do not plan to transfer to a four-year institution.

How Do I Register for Classes?

You can register for classes by logging into your MyGav portal.

- 1. Go to Gavilan's homepage www.gavilan.edu, click on Login or MyGav
- 2. Enter your G# and password
- 3. Click on Student Tab to go to Gavilan Self-Service Banner (yellow box)
- 4. Once in Banner go to Student Tab, and click on Registration
- 5. Click on Search for Classes, select appropriate term, click Submit
- 6. Scroll down list of Subjects, select your subject, click Course Search
- 7. Find your specific class and click on View Sections
- 8. Check a class that works with your schedule and click Register
