Gavilan College, Gilroy - Prior to adjourning to closed session, the Gavilan College Board of Trustees started their December meeting with a well-attended swearing-in ceremony for the newly elected Trustees. The election on November 8 marked the first time Gavilan College trustees had been elected by Trustee Area (TA), rather than at-large.
