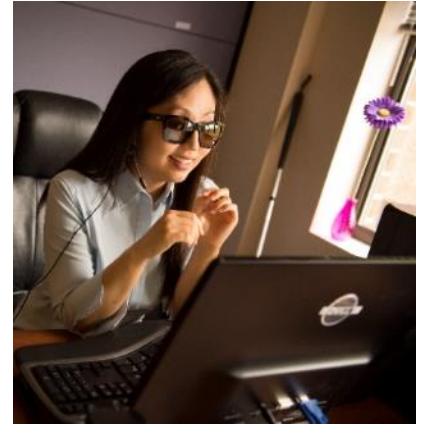




Are you a student or recent graduate with a disability seeking an internship or job?



The Workforce Recruitment Program (WRP) is for talented college students, graduate students, and recent graduates with disabilities to find internships and jobs in the Federal Government. Applying is an excellent way to:

- Find an internship or long-term position at federal agencies
 - Explore government career options
 - Gain interviewing experience

Current degree-seeking undergraduate or graduate students with disabilities and recent graduates who received a postsecondary degree on or after April 1, 2020 from a U.S. accredited college or university are eligible to apply for WRP. Candidates must be U.S. citizens who are eligible for the federal [Schedule A Hiring Authority](#).
