Executive Summary

The ESL Program has recently begun to collaborate again with community-based organizations to articulate ESL courses ranging from literacy to college readiness and citizenship to serve the divergent and evolving needs of second language learners in Hollister, San Juan, Morgan Hill and Gilroy. In response to low enrollment in some online courses, some morning courses, and the advanced level courses, the ESL Program has begun to offer an increasing number of hybrid classes. In Fall 2024, 2 Hyflex classes were offered; in Spring 2025, 6 Hyflex classes are being offered; for Fall 2025, 7 Hyflex classes are planned.

The three goals put forward in the ESL Program Review were:

- 1. Hire an ESL Tutor A tutor has not been hired, as interest in or availability for tutoring is low right now. It is also a challenge to find someone who can tutor the intermediate and advanced levels of ESL.
- 2. Hire a third full-time faculty member We went through the hiring process but did not fill the position in June 2024. There were not many applicants, possibly due to the focus on providing instruction in the jail communities. We have now discovered that it is difficult to open a class at the jails due to the varying levels of the students and the restrictions within the jails.
- 3. Create an ESL 1A there may be an opportunity to begin this work if the AB 705 (MESS Group) is able to plan a retreat for English and ESL faculty in 2025.
