Gavilan College's Fresh Success program is a Basic Needs and Equity initiative supporting students entering Career Education pathways and the workforce who live in San Benito or Santa Clara County and qualify for CalFresh benefits. Through academic counseling, job readiness workshops, and career development

resources, Fresh Success ensures students have a clear educational plan and the skills necessary for employment. We continue to provide resume writing workshops and career readiness training, key components in meeting program goals.

Fresh Success staff conducted in-person and virtual presentations within San Benito County Health and Human Services' Eligibility Unit and Gavilan College non-credit and credit classrooms. We also expanded outreach efforts through participation in Ram-o-Rama (a high school recruitment event), Super Saturday (open enrollment), the San Benito County Fair, Encontrando el Camino (a Spanish-speaking outreach event), and more.

A major milestone in May 2023 was the launch of a common application developed by Gavilan's support programs, allowing students to apply to 10 student support programs simultaneously. This streamlined process removes barriers and expands access to critical resources. The common application is actively promoted through flyers, A-frames, and is required for students accessing El Centro's basic needs support.

As a result of these efforts, Fresh Success has significantly increased student participation, strengthening our commitment to equity, career readiness, and student success.
