Ryan: Issues voiced regarding fundraiser approvals. Proposed for it to be changed so that they do not have to go through AGSC for approval. Would like to see: actual approval form comes from advisors. Facility use request attached.

Timeframe for approval is still 1-2 weeks.

Adam: updated proposal/form

Communication: Discussion over the point of putting proposals to a vote

CC: Discussion regarding time differences between two different forms of proposal

YAFF: Make it mandatory for AGSC and ICC to cover fundraiser discussion during meetings. AGSC and ICC both are eligible for approving fundraising

Ryan: Quick approval process, not as much as a concern. Would rather work towards revising the policy as a whole.

Communication: Going through process of fundraising, fundraiser still dropped

Nolan: Emphasis on punctuality for turning in forms/communication

TADA: Bringing up the possibility of making the process automated through the Canvas Shell.

Nolan: Doable, still requires form to be scanned w/ signatures. Still has an issue with what to do with the form.

Adam: Can create new discussion item for clubs, can collaborate to find a new solution

Vote to change form, Nolan proposed: Everyone voted yes to change

Temporary solution for this semester, fundraisers require three signatures and are approved. 10 unofficial votes of approval.

Nolan: Encouraging involvement in campus and rules, communication encouraged
