

# Two Columns – the same size

<div class="row">
  <div class="col6">
    <p>Column One information goes here</p>
  </div>
  <div class="col6">
    <p>Column Two information goes here</p>
  </div>
</div>
```

Everything in blue is the column code.

A 'div' means division; it is a way of organizing the page. Each '<div>' has a matching '</div>'. One is an opening division; the other is a closing division.

The first 'div' says this is a row. The second 'div' say's this is a column, then it closes the column with '</div>'. The very last '</div>' closes the row.
