FAFSA- Free application for Federal Student Aid

For U.S. citizens and legal residents



CADAA - CA Dream Act Application

•For undocumented or DACA students who meet AB540 requirements



Promise Grants

What does the Promise Cover?

Waives enrollment fees & provides a textbook grant for first-time, full time students (12+ units)

CA College Promise

- FAFSA or CADAA
- California resident or AB540 status
- Financial need of at least \$1180
- Enrollment status not required
- Renewal award during time at Gavilan

Gavilan Promise

- FAFSA or CADAA
- California resident or AB540 status
- Financial need not considered
- 1st Time to college students
- Full-time enrollment status-12+ units
- Participation limited to 2 years

What is Verification?

- You may be required to verify your 2019 income.
- You can upload tax documents & complete forms from your mobile phone or PC using Verify My FAFSA.


How Can You Prepare for Registration?





- 2. Set up Gav ID, Pin Number, and security question
- 3. Complete Placement online (CCC Apply, HS transcript, AP Scores)
- 4. Complete Online Orientation (my gav portal)
- 5. Make a 30-minute appointment with a counselor to complete Ed Plan by Friday April 30th for Priority 3 Registration www.gavilan.edu/counseling
 - a. View MyDegreeWorks Worksheet (my gav account)

How Can You Prepare for Registration? (continued)



- a. Official documents not necessary for advising purposes (prerequisite verification)
- 7. Plan ahead (limited counseling services available in summer)
 - b. Schedule will be posted on <u>counseling website</u>
- 8. Don't forget to apply for Financial aid by completing






